DAY-CARE VACANCIES

In our nearly 200 day-care centres children age 0 to 6 receive loving care and early childhood education.

Step 1: Find vacancy

With the help of our Day-Care Centre Finder, you can find vacancies at our day-care centres. Please get in touch with the team and arrange an appointment for a visit. If you like the place and receive a positive answer, a day-care agreement will be concluded.

Step 2: Kita-Gutschein (day-care voucher)

Equally to local children, children who fled Ukraine are legally entitled to claim daycare in Hamburg. Starting from age one, 5 hours including lunch are free of charge.

If the parents carry on a job, receive training or education, the children can also start at younger age and stay longer hours.

The city of Hamburg bears the costs of the day-care via the voucher.

Children who fled Ukraine can start easily at our day-care centres. The centre's management can help parents with the paperwork and apply in their name for day-care at the local youth welfare office. The parents can submit the signed application form and their registration certificate later on.



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CENTRES FOR PARENTS AND CHILDREN - EKIZ

At many of our day-care centres you will also find centres for parents and children ("Eltern-Kind-Zentrum") – venues for parents, whose children do not yet attend a daycare centre. You are welcome to just stop by. Free admission! You can get to know other families and exchange experiences.
